- ✓ current freshmen, sophomores or juniors in secondary school at the time of application
- ✓ 16-19 years old by July 23, 2022

- ✓ English proficiency to fully participate in discussions and conscientiously complete homework readings (if English is not the applicant's first language or primary language of school, applicants must submit TOEFL iBT scores over 95 or equivalent)

- ✓ passionate about making a positive difference in your local and global community
- ✓ eager to participate in group discussions about global issues
- ✓ excited to build a lifelong community of peers across the world
