The GCI Seminar is a 4-day residential program for secondary school educators and administrators who are interested in exploring how to prepare young people for leadership roles and how to equip them for initiating real change in their communities. Educators will be introduced to key elements of the GCI Method, a curriculum based in ethical leadership and grounded in the methodologies of Discussion-Based Learning, Design Thinking and Human Connectivity.

During the Seminar, Educators will:

- Learn the Harkness® Discussion-Based Learning methodology from Phillips Exeter Academy faculty
- Learn Design Thinking, the human-centric problem-solving framework, from an expert in the field
- Observe students as they participate in Harkness® academic sessions and develop their projects using the Design Thinking techniques
- Hear from inspirational speakers on topics related to social entrepreneurship, leadership, ethics and global citizenship
- Discuss unique classroom experiences, best practices, challenges and insights and establish meaningful and hopefully continuing relationships with other educators from around the globe
